By the single practice of taking faith in Myoho-Renge-Kyo, there are no benefits that will not be drawn to you, and there are no benefits that will fail to come, and no good causes that will fail to be accumulated. These examples illustrate that although the number of meshes in a net is immeasurable, when one pulls the line, all the meshes will be pulled together, and that although the number of threads is innumerable, when one pulls the corner of a piece of cloth, all other threads will be pulled along with it.
