Even if words are strict, if they can help the people, then they can be true and compassionate. On the contrary, even if words sound compassionate, if they ruin people's lives, then they can be false and destructive. Although people think that doctrines elucidated by present scholars are true and compassionate, they actually are destructive and false. This is because they go against the Lotus Sutra, which expounds the Buddha's true intention. Nichiren states that those who chant the Nembutsu will fall into the hell of incessant suffering, and that Zen and Shingon are also erroneous sects. This may sound severe; however, it is true and compassionate.
